Theme of Guided Tours



Starting from August 2012, a number of themed guided tours of the museum will be offered. We believe this choice will enhance the educational value of our tours and make them more suited for groups with different interests. They have a common CORE ELEMENT, in addition to other OPTIONAL THEMES to be chosen at the time of booking.

The CORE ELEMENTS will comprise the following:

- 1. Introductory video on the plague outbreak of 1894, how it was related to insanitary living conditions in the Taipingshan District, discovery of the cause of plague in Hong Kong, and how this episode was a significant turning point in the history of medicine and public health in Hong Kong, leading to the establishment of the Bacteriological Institute in 1906, the building which now houses the museum.
- 2. A tour of the original Old Laboratory, to give an idea of what the original laboratories looked like, and including an account of some of the work done in the Bacteriological Institute to protect the health of the public.

Please also choose one of the themes listed below:

Theme 1

Public Health, Conquest and Prevention of Infectious Diseases, Past and Present

This tour will include:

- A panoramic view of the historical Chinese residential district of Taipingshan
- Introduction to vaccines; a model showing production of vaccines against Smallpox in the old Bacteriological/ Pathological Institute
- ♦ Exhibit on the SARS outbreak of 2003 and its impact
- ♦ The threat of infectious disease



Theme 2

Development of Medical and Health Services in Hong Kong

This tour will present the stories behind the establishment and special contributions of some of Hong Kong's earliest medical institutions:

- ♦ Tung Wah Hospital
- ♦ Alice Ho Miu Ling Nethersole Hospital
- ♦ College of Medicine for Chinese
- Training of nurses and the development of modern midwifery services and their impact
- The transition from use of Traditional Chinese Medicine to Western medicine in different periods of Hong Kong's history



Theme 3

Traditional Chinese Medicine and Western Medicine: Introduction and Comparison

This tour will focus on:

- ♦ Aspects of Traditional Chinese Medicine (TCM), including the Herbalist Shop display
- Equipment used in TCM, including equipment for preparation of herbal medicines, acupuncture and bone-setting
- Comparison between the basic concepts of TCM and Western Medicine using 'The Spleen in Chinese and in Western Medicine' exhibit for illustrative purposes



Theme 4

Appreciation of the Architectural Features of the Museum Building, and Conservation of the protected Monument

Besides the Core Elements which recount the historical events leading to the establishment of the Bacteriological Institute and a visit to the original old laboratory, this tour will introduce visitors:

- ♦ The attractive architectural features of the 100-year old monument
- ♦ Efforts required for conservation of such heritage buildings

All guided tours will last about one hour and 10 minutes. For school groups, it is recommended that a visit of at least one and ½ hours should be planned, to allow for time for the students to view exhibits in the museum on their own.

Museum Opening Hours:

Tuesdays – Saturdays 10:00am – 5:00pm Sundays & public holidays 1:00pm - 5:00pm

Closed on Mondays, Christmas Day, New Year's Day and the first three days of the Lunar New Year. For Lunar New Year's Eve and Christmas Eve, it opens from 10:00am to 3:00pm

Charges:

Admission Fee: Adults: HK\$20.00

Concession: HK\$10.00 (for children, full-time students, seniors aged 60 or above, and

persons with disability)

For registered group (with 15 persons or more) which can settle payment 10 days prior to date of visit (date of post stamp), admission fee for group leaders will be waived,

30%-discounted tickets will further be offered.

Docent Service Fee: The docent fee for each guided tour (maximum 18 persons for a group) is \$250, maximum

2 groups for each session (except by special arrangement). Docent services are

provided by the Museum from Tuesday to Friday. Service on Saturday is negotiable.

Procedures:

- 1. Phone the Museum office to reserve visit time slot and date, and arrange the guided tour.

- 3. If the application is successful, a confirmation notice would be sent to the applicant. If no reply is received from the Museum one week before the date of visit, please contact the Museum immediately.
- 4. Application for group visits can be made 3 months in advance preferably 4 weeks before the date of visit. Visits will be arranged on a first-come-first-served basis.

- 6. All matters and disputes will be subject to the final decision of the Museum office. In case of any discrepancy between the English and Chinese versions of these terms and conditions, the English version shall prevail.
